Monthly Devotional - ADVENT

Sunday 30th November is the first Sunday of Advent, the season of the year, when our thoughts turn once again to the coming of God to the earth as the babe of Bethlehem, Jesus. The one who left the glories of heaven to demonstrate God's love for the world and that means you and me. The word 'advent' is derived from two Latin words 'ad' - to or towards and 'veni' - to come, so advent is to come towards a special event and there is no event that surpasses the coming of Jesus to earth. No matter how young or how old we are we must never lose the sense of awe and wonder of Christmas.

There is so much commercialisation these days, there is the danger of taking CHRIST out of CHRIST-MAS, and it is so easy to get caught up in it. However, as Christians we should have that sense of anticipation as we watch and wait the approach of Christmas Day. 'Prepare the Way' is the message from the Bible. How can we prepare the way for Jesus coming afresh into our lives. Here are some suggestions from Rev. Dave Bishop to prepare a different space for God during Advent.

Week 1 - Clear the mind; turn off the noise for 10 minutes a day and sit in stillness.

Week 2 - Soften the heart: think of someone you need to forgive or reach out to.

Week 3 - Open hands: do one act of generosity that costs you something.

Week 4 - Lift the eyes: spend time in gratitude, naming what God has already given you.

Advent isn't about pretending to be holy; it's about making space for the Holy One.

So may each one of us know afresh the Blessing that Christmas brings.
