



## SAINTS

Saturday, 1<sup>st</sup> November, was **All Saints' Day**. Throughout the centuries, the Roman Catholic Church has made a number of people saints - indeed, this has even happened quite recently with the recognition of a young man as a saint. However, the Bible teaches that **all who know and love the Lord Jesus Christ as their Saviour and Lord** are saints. That means you and me, brothers and sisters, if we have a personal relationship with God through Jesus Christ.

There are many verses in the New Testament that affirm this truth - that all true believers in Christ are seen by God as saints. Here are just a few: 1 Corinthians 1:2 - Paul writes to the church of God in Corinth, that is, to every believer there. Ephesians 1:15–18 - Paul gives thanks and prays for all believers. Romans 5:18 and Romans 8:26–27 - both remind us of the righteousness and intercession we have through Christ and the Spirit.

Surprisingly, there are also references to saints in the Old Testament - for example, **1 Samuel 2:9** and several passages in the **Psalms**. I am especially encouraged by **Revelation 5:8**, where John, in his vision, sees the twenty-four elders kneeling before the throne, presenting golden bowls full of incense - **the prayers of the saints** - to the One seated on the throne. Those are *our* prayers, and in His perfect will and purpose, God hears and answers them.

So, brothers and sisters, be encouraged! God the Father sees **you** as a saint because of your faith and trust in Jesus, His Son. Yet with this blessing comes a challenge - to live lives worthy of His Name, so that through our thoughts, words, and deeds we bring glory and honour to Him.

We are saints not only on 1st November, but every day, as we seek to serve one another and the communities in which God has placed us. Your brother in Christ, Alastair
