

ALL-AGE DEVOTIONAL: USING A TURNSTILE

If you've ever been to a big football or rugby match, you'll know how exciting it is before the game starts - crowds gather, fans sing, and everyone wears their team's colours. But before anyone can sit down in the stadium, there's one thing they must do first: get through the turnstile. A turnstile is a special gate. It only lets one person through at a time, and only if that person has a valid ticket.

Now picture the scene at the National Stadium in Cardiff before a big rugby match. One very excited fan shows up. He's wearing the team scarf, knows all the chants, and has even brought the match programme. He's clearly a true supporter. But when he gets to the gate, the attendant stops him. 'Sorry,' they say, 'you don't have a ticket.'

The fan is shocked. 'But I love this team! I follow every game. I know all the rules. I came with friends who have tickets!' Still, the answer is the same: 'You can't come in without your own ticket.' That might sound unfair, but the rule is clear - no matter how passionate or well-prepared you are, you need a ticket. There's no other way in.

This story reminds us of something far more important than a rugby game. A lot of people think they'll get into Heaven because they've lived a good life, gone to church, given to charity, or come from a Christian family. But Jesus said, 'I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved.' (John 10:9)


